As a certified B Corp company, we can join the ranks of big names like Dopper, Tony Chocolonely and Ben & Jerry's. Companies that are going for it to make a difference globally. In early 2023, 178 companies in the Netherlands were allowed to call themselves a B Corp and now we too are officially part of this movement!



B Corp companies strive to keep the earth healthy, livable and safe, for today's generation and for later. They do this mainly by contributing positively and actively to people and society.

B Corporation is an independent quality mark awarded by B Lab, initiator of this movement, after a thorough audit on 5 impact areas. These include fair wages and working conditions (throughout the production and trade chain) and overall social commitment.

Since the founding of R-Go Tools "We care for people in need" has always been one of our main mission statements.

Adhering to the B Corp guidelines is natural for us but nevertheless it reinforces and underlines our dedication to making the world a better place.



What makes R-Go Tools a B Corp?

Via the Tools4Life foundation, R-Go Tools is committed to various social areas. At least 10% of the profits thus go to various development projects. For example, R-Go Tools collaborates with the Agua Viva foundation in Brazil, and social workplaces in the Netherlands. In addition, we are a clothing collection point for Stichting CRR (Christian Refugee Relief), so that various refugee camps in Europe can be provided with clothes. All in all, we achieved a score of over 120 points (out of a highest possible score of 200 points, 82 of which were required)!



Your health is our priority!


Healthy living and healthy working is important for everyone. That's why we design ergonomic products with you in mind! With our ergonomic expertise, we design affordable ergonomic solutions that help you work healthily. Whether you work at home, in the office or on the road, we always have a solution that fits you.



Ergonomically designed with you in mind

When designing our products, we take into account anthropometry (human geometry), ergonomic principles and applicable (occupational health and safety) guidelines.

We strive for ergonomic solutions that fit everyone, regardless of your height, posture and left- or right-handedness. Because computer work can quickly lead to tension on small muscles and tendons in the wrists and hands, we design the keyboards and mice so that minimal muscle tension is required to operate them. In the testing phase, we therefore also use muscle tension gauges. Our new products are evaluated by external ergonomists and a panel of test users.

AGR certified

We are proud that our products have achieved the leading AGR seal of approval.

What is AGR? AGR stands for "Aktion Gesunder Rücken," which in English means "Campaign Healthy Backs." This initiative started over 25 years ago by a German collective of experts and scientists from various professional groups. This team of experts tests whether products comply with ergonomic guidelines and actually prevent physical complaints. This leads to a highly nuanced and substantiated verdict:

AGR-worthy or not.

A product with the AGR certificate has been ergonomically tested and recommended. It is a 100% reliable, officially recognized seal of approval that assures customers of the ergonomics of the product. Such a product stands out from other products whose ergonomics are not officially proven.

Originally developed in Germany, the AGR Label is a decisive and recognised seal of approval worldwide.

AGR is found today in many industries where ergonomics are important, for example, AGR-approved car seats in the automotive industry.



What are we planning for the future?





We care for People in need

Helping people in need is our passion!

It is our passion to help people in need, to give people a second chance in life and on the job market. For example, we support several development projects worldwide via our Tools4Life foundation. We also collaborate with several social workshops in the Netherlands for the assembly of our Steel laptop stands. Our felt protective bags are custom made by i-Did, an exceptional social enterprise that makes products from recycled textiles. Finally, our Leerdam office is a clothing collection point for CRR Foundation (Christian Refugee Relief), so that refugees in Southern Europe can be provided with clothing.

Foundation Tools4Life

We donate more than 10% of our profits to development projects via our Tools4Life foundation. This way, we aim to give those in need and living in poverty the means to be able to provide for themselves.

Projects supported in 2024

Foundation Christian Refugee Relief (CRR)

Among other things, CRR sends monthly aid shipments to refugee camps in Southern Europe. Tools4Life provides financial support and opened an official clothing collection point at Techniekweg 15 in Leerdam in late 2022.

Foundation Heartview for you

Heartview for you is a Christian foundation that does a lot of charitable work in the Netherlands, Romania, Peru and India. In doing so, they maintain contact with missionaries in needy areas locally.









Foundation Agua Viva

Agua Viva is a foundation in Brazil that provides addiction care. The Foundation is committed to teaching former addicts a trade so that they are able to provide for themselves and thus more easily reintegrate into society.

A study project in Mozambique

Tools4Life was able to give Madalena from Mozambique an opportunity to train as a cook. She successfully completed this training in early 2024 and can now earn her own living as a cook!

DTS' Eva

We are financially supporting our former colleague Eva van Eck for a period of six months. She is on a mission trip to Hawaii, in order to assist the church and the local people. Eva is attending a Discipleship Training School of Performing Arts Dance.


Collaborations

Avres

Even closer to home, we try to give people better opportunities in life. We do this by regularly outsourcing manual labor to one of Avres' sheltered workshops. People who, for various reasons, have difficulty keeping up with society are employed and can find suitable work and a sense of self-worth because of Avres.


i-Did

We work together with i-Did, which also has a sheltered workshop where underprivileged people can learn a trade. I-Did makes new felt utensils and interior objects from old textiles. We are extremely happy with the felt pouches for our Split keyboard and our Twister mouse that i-Did is making especially for us. Besides being social, these pouches are of course also a sustainable product-two good causes in one!

What are we planning for the future?

In 2025, R-Go Tools will travel to Romania to find a new project. We will look for people whom we can support. The intention is to start a project in order to create jobs by producing new products or accessories. Ideally, we want to offer people who need it the chance to learn new skills that will help them get on in life.

Our environment

With care for the environment

We feel responsible to be good stewards of the earth on which we live. This means that we think carefully about how our products should be made and what materials we use.





One Tree Planted

We want to contribute to the environment by ensuring lower emissions in production. To determine the environmental impact of our products, we conduct LCAs (life cycle analyses) for our monitor arms.

Our Caparo monitor arm for example has an impact of 14.3kg of CO2 which is the equivalent of driving 44.9 Km by car. We offset every Kg of CO2 required to produce our monitor arms by planting trees via the non-profit organisation "One Tree Planted".







Ecovadis Platinum Certified

To clarify our social impact and continue to develop in the future, we engaged EcoVadis in 2022. As an independent organization EcoVadis assesses companies' policies on corporate social responsibility. EcoVadis reviewed R-Go Tools policies and practices in the following areas: "The environment", "Labor and Human Rights", "Ethics" and "Sustainable Procurement".

As a result, we are now confirmed as a socially responsible company. Everything is assessed annually, and we are were delighted with our final score, which confirmed R-Go Tools qualify for a platinum medal from EcoVadis in 2024 placing us in the top 1% of all companies evaluated.

Circular design

In our opinion, sustainability starts with the design. Therefore, we consider the principles of "Circular Product Design" when designing our products. For example, our products reduce waste and emissions of harmful substances into soil, air and water.

As a further example, our monitor arms are designed so that the aluminium and plastic can be easily separated, making the product completely recyclable. We have received a "100% circularity" certificate for this. Our mice and keyboards are about 85% recyclable

Products/packaging

Furthermore, for our packaging, we choose sustainable materials as much as possible and use FSC cardboard with minimal environmental impact. And the felt pouches for our Split keyboard and Twister mouse have been recycled by i-Did from old textiles.





What are we planning for the future?

We constantly inform ourselves about the latest developments in the area of sustainability to see how we can improve within our current and future product range and general business operations. Of course, in 2025 we will again aim for the Ecovadis Platinum Medal and, if possible, achieve an even higher ranking in the top of all evaluated companies. For example, we will be switching to post-consumer plastics for our mice and keyboards instead of post-production.
